

Management of Sub-contractors Course

A 1-day course for construction team members who want to make an impact on managing and improving sub-contractors' performance

Aim and Target Audience

The aim of the course is to provide delegates with an understanding of the importance of sub-contractors and supply chains in delivering construction projects and how to get the best performance possible. The course is suitable for people who have some site experience. For example, site engineers, quantity surveyors, supervisors, managers new entrants, or people simply requiring an update.

- 1. understand the importance of sub-contractors, supply chains and collaborative working
- 2. identify, assess and manage sub-contract risks
- 3. be aware of the types of sub-contractor, standard forms of subcontract and the main contractual issues
- 4. know good sub-contractor management processes to procure, engage, plan, coordinate, control and review sub-contractors' performance.
