CECA has announced it is to partner with Cancer Research UK and industry charity Mates in Mind to deliver the 2020 'Stop. Make a Change' campaign 'SMAC-20.'

'Stop. Make a Change' is the only campaign of its sort in the UK construction sector, in which sites, offices and production facilities down tools to focus on working together to build a healthier, safer industry.

This year the campaign is to run between 10-23 October, to coincide with World Mental Health Day and the European Week for Safety & Health. SMAC-20 will entail employees from across the industry engage in conversations, focussing on specific topics with relevance to individual health, enabling those working in UK construction to reengage with their own health, safety and wellbeing, and to ask themselves what needs to be changed, along with how they might go about making that change.
