

Inspiring Careers — Shaping the Future

Thank you for choosing to participate at Inspiring Careers — Shaping the Future. This document contains information about the event for exhibitors, such as how to take part in the event and engage with young people, as well how to maintain continuous engagement once event is over.

Who is LikeToBe?

LikeToBe is the online career network which introduces students to professional online networking and creates regular, employer engagement. It was designed to connect students in geographically and socially isolated areas with employers to provide opportunities for all, regardless of their location or background.

LikeToBe are partnering with Plymouth City Council, Plymouth City Bus and Devon & Plymouth Chamber of Commerce to host the county-wide Inspiring Careers event.

How does the virtual event work?

Instead of the familiar face-to-face career events, this is a virtual event hosted on the LikeToBe platform. Similar to traditional career events, the event includes career talks, Q&As via the forum, livestreams, workshops and career opportunities within the different zones. The event will run from 10:30-14:30 and 18:00-20:00 to include an evening slot for young people to engage with the site alongside their parents. Importantly, after the event the content will remain available for visitors to engage with.

To navigate the event, please read the guides on the following pages for navigating the event home page (page 3) and the event zone pages (page 4).

Who will be visiting?

Visitors will be able to access the event when they register on the platform and will be starting on the main event page. From here, they will be able to navigate between each of the zones to explore the different exhibitors; listening to career talks, applying to opportunities, and asking questions to find out more.

When visitors ask a question in your secure forum, the moderator/admin of your page will instantly get an email notification. You can then reply directly to their question, or do so at a later point. If you want to add more moderators, simply go to your organisation's profile page and click on "Add New Educator" or "Add New Staff member." Students are able to follow your page in order to receive updates from you in their newsfeed. To find out how many people are following you, go to your Newsfeed tab.

What is a virtual exhibitor booth?

Your profile page will be your **virtual exhibitor booth** which will exist long after the event. Visitors will be directed to your virtual booth after watching your short video presented at the event. Please have a look at our "How to optimise your organisation page" guide to enhance your profile. In short, you can:

- Add information about your organisation or individual
- Add updates to your timeline
- Upload videos and important resources
- Invite students to follow you
- Feature opportunities such as virtual work experience
- Answer student questions in your own forum

What do you need to prepare?

To prepare for the event, there are a couple of steps that you will need to complete:

- 1. Create your own personalised, virtual booth on the LikeToBe platform (page 5).
- 2. Create a short (3 minutes), inspirational video for students to watch (please see the Speaker guide on page 6) and send this to bec@liketobe.org
- 3. Respond on the **25th March** to questions posted on your secure forum. You will receive an email notification letting you know when something has been posted!

What is next?

Besides preparing your virtual booth for the event, there are several other steps important to take before and after the event:

- Start following LikeToBe by clicking on the yellow button "Follow" next to the logo on the event page -> https://www.liketobe.org/organisations/liketobe/profile
- Keep your virtual booth updated in the weeks/days leading up to & after the event
- Schedule a follow-up call with us after the event to discuss the event and future opportunities on our platform

- 1. How do I edit/update my profile? Click on the edit button right of your logo on your profile page.
- 2. How do I change the image for the logo and the banner?

While editing your profile, just upload a new image and this will automatically change the logo/banner.

3. Can I add a video to the resources tab?

The website currently only supports urls from YouTube and Vimeo.

4. What can I add to my timeline?
You can add an image or a video (url from YouTube or Vimeo) in addition to text and links in the text box.

WHAT WE WANT YOU TO CREATE:

A short 3-7 minute engaging and inspiring career talk, This could be a video or a narrated presentation. Topics can range from career journey to employability skills - whatever you think would capture the interest of young people!

USEFUL POINTERS

- · Who you are, who you work for, your job title and roleHow did you get there?
- What is good about working at your organisation?
- What are the career routes into the industry
- · Tips/comments/suggestions for young people

FILMING TIPS

- · You do not need complicated equipment, a smartphone will do the job. Landscape orientation works best.
- · Light source should come from behind the camera.
- . Try to look directly into the camera and keep it steady.
- · Practice and do several takes before the final video.
- · Ask for feedback from friend/colleague
