Our aims:

• To improve men's mental health

• To prevent suicide in men



Why these aims?

- Globally, one man dies by suicide every minute
- In the England, Scotland and Wales
 12 men die by suicide each day.
 That is one every other hour.
- In the construction industry, 2 men take their lives each day.
 - 84% of men in the construction industry said they wanted to improve their mental health
- Only 30% of men in the construction industry said their workplace had meaningful well being initiatives.
