Safe Digging; Let's Make a Difference - May 7th 2026 JCB VIP Visitor Centre, Uttoxeter, ST14 5LS

CECA Midlands in conjunction with a number of CECA regions, Green Power Site Solutions and JCB in Uttoxeter, are holding a 'Safe Digging' event, on **Thursday 7th May 2026**. The day will start at 9.30am with registration. Actual start will be at 10.00am and will close at 2.45pm.

Around 60,000 service strikes happen each year. Important utility cables that provide homes and businesses with vital resources such as water, gas and electricity are hazards to our workforce and need to be managed carefully to avoid damage to the asset and personal injury.

The event will highlight issues around working on utility services and will include presentations, videos and examples of good practice. Presentations will be given by NUAR (National Underground Asset Register), Mike Legg - a personal story, Hills Safety Training, JCB, Green Power Site Solutions, Barhale And CSCS. There will also be the opportunity to visit the JCB museum and view a video of Vac-Ex equipment and there will also be the opportunity to engage in networking discussions.
